Dear Parents,

Netball club will start again on Tuesday 19th September and runs every Tuesday from 3.30pm to 4.30pm. All children in years 5 and 6 are welcome, both boys and girls, of all abilities, including complete beginners. If more than 60 children apply to join the club, places will be offered on a first come, first served basis. Children must wear PE kit, especially trainers, and can bring a drink and snack to have before the club starts. At the end of the session, children should be fetched from the main school entrance, not from the netball court, and must have signed parental permission to either go home alone or be fetched from the end of Banner Farm Road.

We enter two teams into the Tunbridge Wells league, an A and a B team, and players for these matches will be chosen from pupils regularly attending the club, regardless of their year group. We try and choose different children for the teams so that every child gets a chance to represent their school in a match at some point. We will warn you, however, that other teams in the district are extremely competitive – we are proud to play well, play fairly and do our very best at all times. Matches are held at Skinners' Kent Academy on Tuesday evenings at 3.45pm and you will be informed if your child is asked to play.

We would be very grateful to hear from any parents who are able to help with the club on a regular basis, either at training, or even by accompanying children and refereeing at matches at SKA. You do not have to be a county player to do this, and we can offer training if necessary.
