### NLE support

One of her key strengths is enabling middle leaders to become strategic in their leadership and thinking, leading to a sustainable school leadership model; currently she is leading a Strategic Middle Leaders Course.

- introduced new equipment for whole school change;
- given inset training around curriculum and the excitement of maths;
- given inset training around bar modelling;
- reviewed curriculums and whole school maths practice, providing support for middle leaders, including Ofsted readiness; and
- hosted numerous maths workshops to engage parents across the primary curriculum.
