There is a special **Around the World menu** for the w/c 7th May. Please see attached.

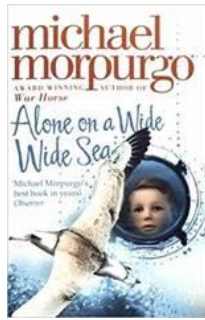
