## Whole School

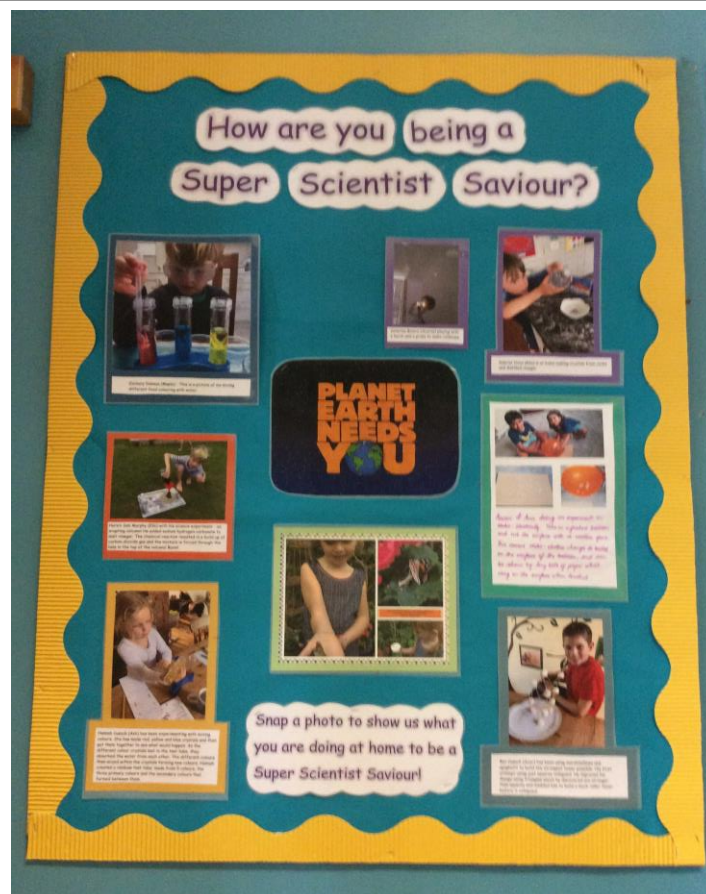
